



DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR MARRIAGE BETWEEN FOREIGN CITIZENS

- **PASSPORT:** Original and copies (Bride, Groom and 4 witnesses) TOURIST CARDS or Legal Migratory Document (FM 3- FM2) Current copies (Bride, Groom and 4 witnesses)
- **BIRTH CERTIFICATES:** Originals and Apostilled copies translated into Spanish. Apostilled must be requested in the place where the document was issued. Translations must be done in Mexico by an official authority.
- **FINAL DIVORCE DECREES** or Death Certificate or change of name document: if applicable, original and Apostilled copy, translated into Spanish. The Divorce Decree must have been signed at least one year prior to the new marriage.
- **BLOOD TEST** & Medical Certificate issued in Mexico.
- **WITNESSES:** four adults, must bring their Passports and Tourist Cards. Bride & Groom and four (4) witnesses must be in Cancun at least 3 full business days before the Wedding (does not include arrival date, weekend, Mexican holidays or wedding date)

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR MARRIAGE BETWEEN A MEXICAN CITIZEN AND A FOREIGNER:

- All of the above
- Migration Permission Document. Marriage permits for foreigner authorizing vows between foreigner and Mexican National from the state's Migration office.
- All Mexican Citizens must present the document stating that they are single by the Registrar Office in Chetumal. More information: www.inami.gob.mx
